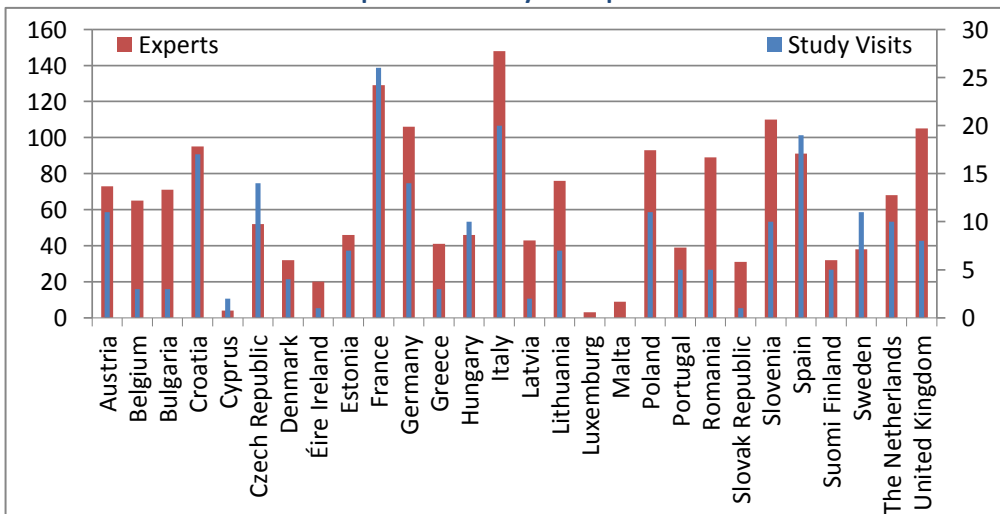

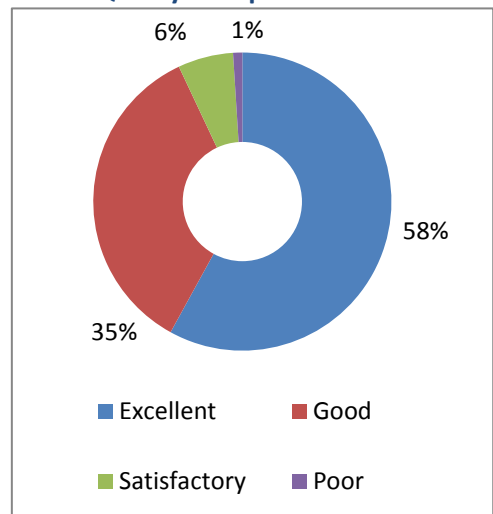

Number of Experts and Study Visits per Member State



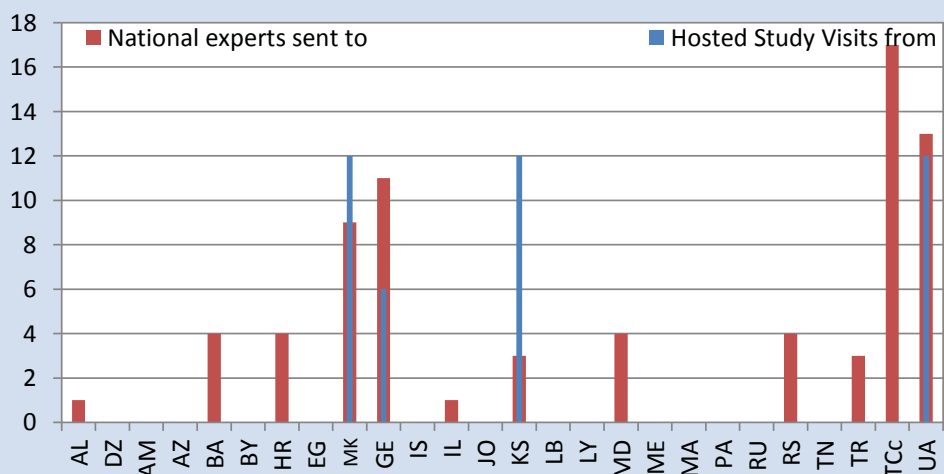
Quality of Experts in 2015

### Lithuania

In the first semester of 2015, TAIEX performance was in line with the overall mid-year objectives. The number of implemented activities in the IPA beneficiaries and ENI South countries remained at the level of the corresponding period of 2014, while a significant increase was registered in the ENI East region. Overall, also the number of participants to TAIEX events and of experts mobilised increased.
